

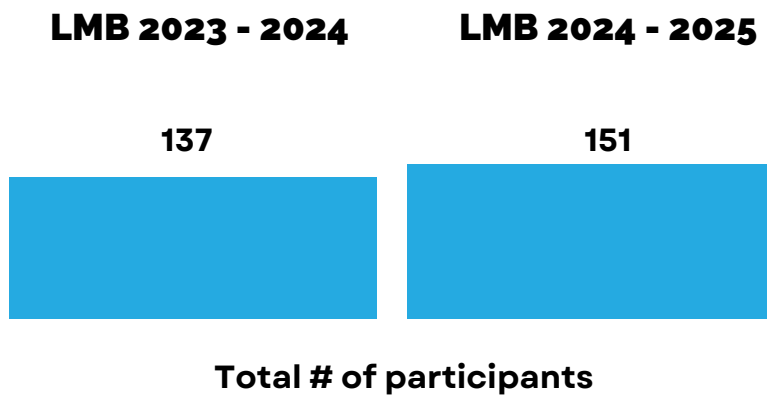


Latino Men & Boys 2024 - 2025 Infographic

Participant Demographics

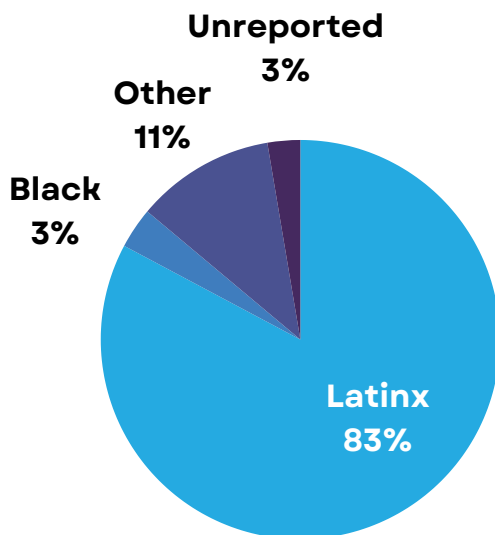
During the 2024 - 2025 school year, The LMB Program served **151** participants.



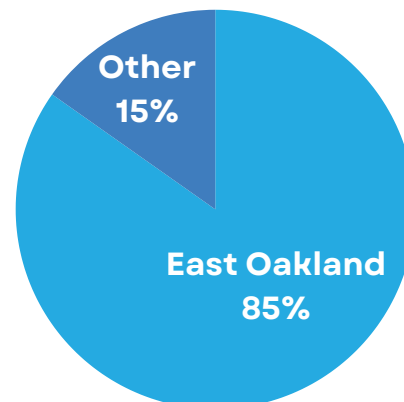
The LMB Program served **10% more** participants than last year

Zip Code Region



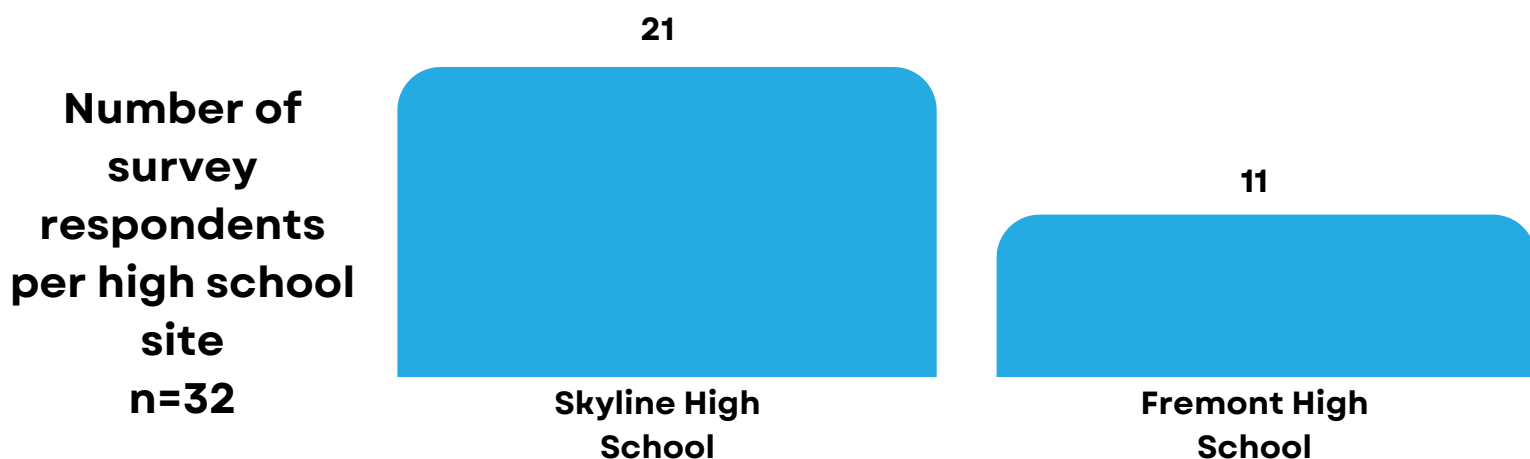
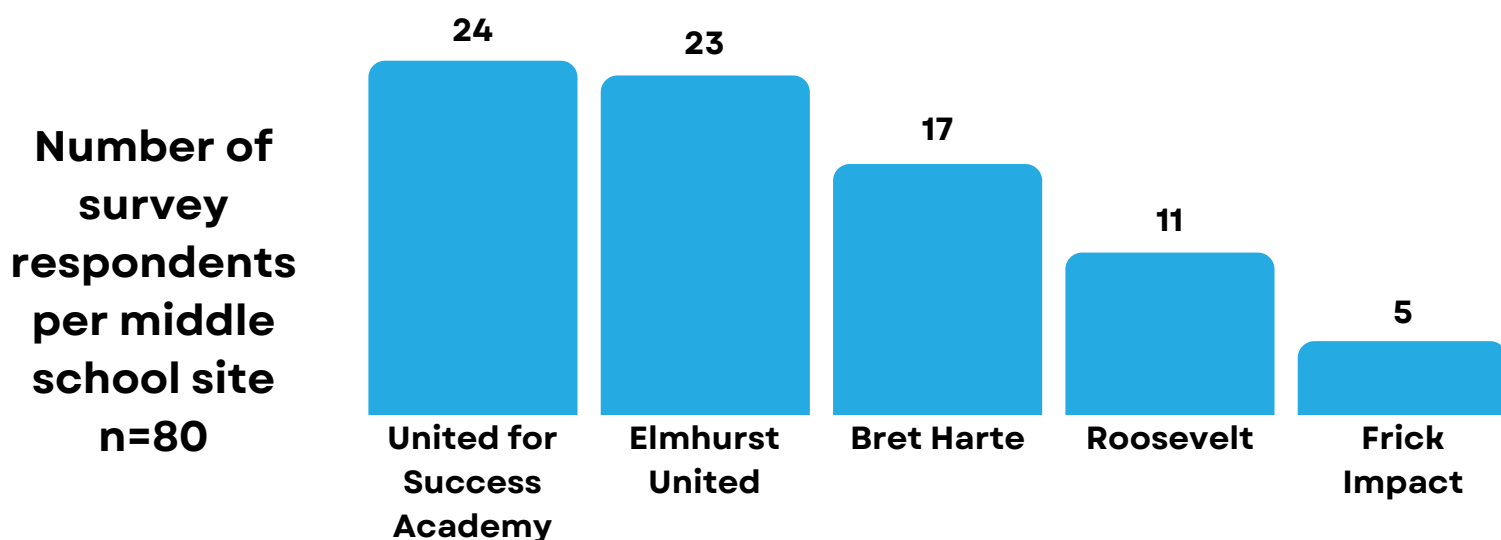
The East Oakland region includes the following zip codes: 94601, 94603, 94605, 94606, 94619, and 94621

Program Impact

Quick Facts:

- **641** check-ins to support participants' needs
- **265** classroom push-ins/pull-outs to support participants
- **274** sports and recreation activities to promote participants' physical well-being
- **\$3,000** distributed in milestones and stipends

112 out of 151 (74%) LMB participants completed the exit survey
